Key safety messages

- We will never knowingly ask your staff to carry out work in an unsafe manner.
- You are responsible for the actions of those you employ (including any subcontractors) and send to work for the Trust.
- You will be required to participate in our appraisal process and provide us with information regarding your management of general health and safety, including relevant risks associated with the work you are contracted to perform for the Trust.



Key safety messages

- Your safety (and that of our customers) comes before the job; if your staff think a task is unsafe, tell them to STOP IMMEDIATELY and speak to your Trust contacts.
- We operate a safety culture where we're always open to new ideas or ways
 of working that reduce Health and Safety risks; don't keep good ideas to
 yourself!
- You will be required to adhere to the document entitled "site rules for contractors" (found elsewhere on the site as a downloadable PDF) at all times. Non-compliance with our site rules may result in your teams being instructed to stop works or removed from our site. Repeated breaches may lead to the termination of your contract and removal from our approved list of contractors for any future work.
